Policy for Donation of Used Pianos:

It is the goal of The Mundi Project **Piano Bank Program** to place donated pianos with public organizations that will use them to provide the general public -primarily youth, greater access to pianos for performances, practice, workshops, and outreach programs.

Once a piano is placed with an organization, the organization will retain ownership and be fully responsible for the instrument and its maintenance. The Mundi Project will place a plaque on the piano and requests that the organization return it to The Mundi Project if for some reason there is no longer a need for its placement.

The Mundi Project will work with each organization on a case by case basis to arrange the initial move and tuning of the piano. In most cases, we ask the organization share some of the costs of this process.

Review Process

All applications will be reviewed by the Piano Bank Committee. The needs of the applying organization will be considered as pianos become available for placement and every attempt will be made to ensure each piano is placed where it can be utilized most effectively. Reviews are held quarterly and application are due by the 12th day of January, April, July and October. You will receive a response two weeks after the deadline.
